So, how do I read the New Testament in one year?

The plan is simple. Start on the first Monday of the year, January 4, 2010 by reading the first chapter of the New Testament, Matthew 1. Then read one new chapter every weekday and take the weekends off. Actually, use the weekends to re-read sections you found most interesting or confusing. In addition, if you really want to learn the language of Scripture, here are some tips to help you make this an enjoyable experience:

1. Like any exercise, make reading the Bible a daily habit
2. As you read, take notes

When you have finished reading your chapter for the day, ask yourself the following questions:

What is God saying to us through this passage?

What does this passage tell us about God?

How does this passage speak to us as individuals and to us as a community?

What does this passage teach us about our neighbors and our world?

4. Take a few minutes to pray.

Throughout the day, try to put into practice what you learned from your readings.

Now, enjoy!
