C: ⁶The nations are in an uproar, the kingdoms totter; he utters his voice, the earth melts.

L: ⁷The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge.

C: ⁸Come, behold the works of the LORD; see what desolations he has brought on the earth.

L: ⁹He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; he breaks the bow, and shatters the spear; he burns the shields with fire.
